▶ INFORMATION

- ▶ qualitative variety – group A,
- ▶ tall and lodging-resistant plants that give a lot of straw and grains,
- ▶ recommended for cultivation throughout the country,
- ▶ well-balanced, plump grain with a high falling number and a large weight per hectolitre,
- ▶ insensitive to delayed seeding.
