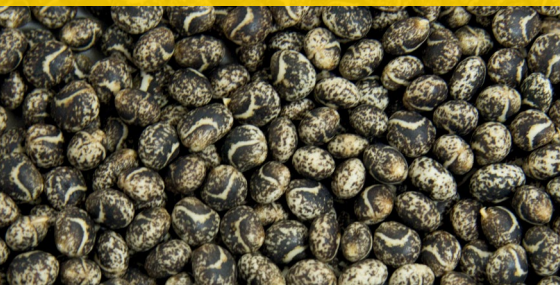

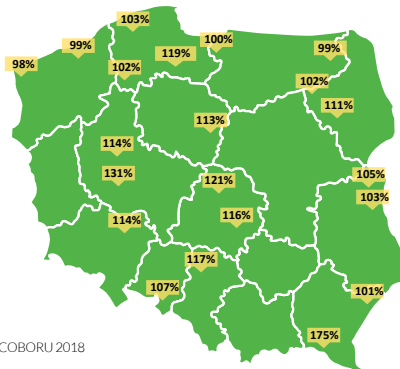

Plants of medium height with medium flowering period, medium maturing period and low TSW. Orange-yellow flowers and white-seeds.



Variety with very high seed yield (up to 110% of standard in COBORU research).



A variety with high resistance to diseases such as fusarium and anthracnose.



Insensitive to delayed sowing, which gives a flexible sowing date.



Very sweet variety, with one of the lowest content of alkaloids in seeds. The results of the research have shown its usefulness in feeding weaners, porkers and poultry. In the tested concentrates, post-extraction soy-bean meal was replaced with lupine, and it was also used in mixtures with blue lupine and peas.



It is characterized by a low yield loss in drought conditions.
