- Very good fodder stock and very high feeding value – protein content in grain highest among all varieties available on the market.
- High tolerance to drought stress.

- Low plants with high lodging resistance.
- High yield potential – up to 7 t/ha according to COBORU in 2021.
- Variety with late earing date and mid full maturity date.
- Medium soil requirements and medium tolerance to soil acidification.
- Very high disease resistance especially to barley rust and powdery mildew.
- Very large, coarse grain with high TGW, low amount of inferior fodder grain.
