

# YELLOW LUPINE DIAMENT



- The sweetest variety on the market – lowest alkaloid content.
- High nutritional value (high protein yield).

- Medium height plants, with early flowering, mid-early maturity dates.
- Orange-yellow flowers and white seeds.
- Very high yield potential – 105% of the pattern in 2021.
- Very high nutritional value, due to high protein content and low alkaloid content.
- Low crude fiber content – better forage digestibility.
- Exceptional health contributing to better yields.
- A variety with the highest resistance to fusarium wilt of lupines.
- Fine seeds (low TSW) combined with high germination capacity result in lower seeding rate – reducing cost of sowing.
- Short period from sowing to the beginning of flowering and uniformity of ripening – easier harvesting.
