- High disease resistance.
- One of the sweetest varieties on the market.

- Medium height plants, with early flowering, mid-early maturity dates.
- Yellow flowers, spotted black and white seeds.
- Very high yield potential (up to 112% of the pattern in COBORU testing).
- Seeds with low TSW – lower seeding costs.
- Plants with very high resistance to typical lupine diseases such as fusarium and anthracnose.
- Sweet seeds with reduced alkaloid content and devoid of gramine, an amino acid that adversely affects the nutritional value of the resulting feed.
- High nutritional value.
- Variety awarded the Gold Medal of the 2020 Agrotech Kielce Fair and Gold Medal of the 2020 Polagra Premiery Exhibition.
